**SUBJECT: SCHOOL MONITORING ON BASIC EDUCATION SERVICES DELIVERY
AND VALIDATION AND SURVEILLANCE OF LEARNERS WHO HAVE
BEEN ADMINISTERED WITH DENGVAXIA VACCINE**

DATE: January 10, 2018

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1. This office announces the commencement of School Monitoring on Basic Education Services Delivery with Inclusion of Validation and Surveillance of Learners who have been administered with Dengvaxia Vaccine.
 2. This activity aims to:
 - a. determine the level of Basic Education Services delivery in schools;
 - b. review the Master list of learners given the dengue vaccine (regardless of the number of doses), and flag these children for very close monitoring for any symptoms of fever and;
 - c. check the postings of *Information, Education and Communication (IEC)* materials (see attached) and initiate the referral report when necessary.
 3. For Dengvaxia Vaccine validation and surveillance, monitoring officials are advised to give premium on school administrators to remind and enjoin to strictly adhere to the provisions of DepEd Memorandum No. 152, s. 2011 entitled ***Preventing Dengue in Schools to Ensure that Schools Regularly Conduct Vector Control Measures to Eliminate Mosquitoes in the School Environment***. This is also to emphasize the urgency of the anti-dengue drive through the 4-S Strategy, which stands for Search and Destroy, Seek early consultation, Self-protective measures, and Say "no" to indiscriminate fogging.
 4. All monitoring officials are instructed to submit consolidated accomplishment report every Friday of the week utilizing the given format. (to be uploaded soonest)
 5. For information and strict compliance of all concerned.



and Education Campaign (IEC) Materials Dissemination

The Department of Education, in close coordination with the Department of Health (DOH), and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), began the implementation of a strengthened monitoring and surveillance system for learners who have received the dengue vaccine through DM No. 199, s. 2017 dated 7 Dec 2017, entitled *Monitoring and Surveillance of Learners Who Have Been Administered With Dengvaxia Vaccine*.

As part of the Department's coordination efforts with DOH, the Regional Directors of regions where vaccination has been conducted, namely, DepEd RO III, IV-A, VII, and the National Capital Region, are hereby instructed to provide assistance to DOH Health Promotion Officers in the distribution of IEC materials on *Dengvaxia* vaccination. In particular, the posting of these IEC materials in strategic places visible to learners, their parents, and the concerned public in all schools in the said regions should be ensured.

Aside from the dissemination of IEC materials, DOH shall also be sending out letters from Dr. Francisco T. Duque III, Secretary of Health, to the parents of learners who have been administered with the *Dengvaxia* vaccine. In this regard, please anticipate responses from the parents and prepare accordingly.

Prominent concern of parents/guardians is the severe outcome of the vaccine to their children including the cost of treatment should their children be hospitalized, among others.



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

Nabakunahan na ng DengVaxia ang aking anak. Ano ang dapat kong gawin?

- Magkipag-ugnayan sa paaralan o sa pinakamalapit na RHU pang matiyak na ang inyong anak ay kasama sa master list ng DOH.
- Katulong ng DOH ang DepEd at lokal na pamahalaan para ipatupad ang pinaligtas na monitoring and surveillance ng mga batang nabakunahan sa mga susunod na taon.
- Bantayang mabuti ang inyong anak at sisiguruhin na sakaling magkasintomas ng Dengue ay handa ang RHU at pampublikong ospital na agarang gamutin ang inyong anak.
- Dahil hindi 100% epektibo ang DengVaxia, maari pa ring magkaroon ng Dengue ang inyong anak. Pareho pa rin ang preventive measures na inererekомenda ng DOH upang makalwas sa Dengue.



Hinihikayat ang lahat na magpapatupad ng 4S KONTRA DENGUE:

1. **SEARCH AND DESTROY BREEDING PLACES** - o ang pagtahahanap at pagsira sa mga lugar na puedeng pangtagtan ng lamok, katulad ng mga baldes, tansan, galung, platera at iba pang halagyan na maaring maipunan ng malinis na tubig.
2. **SEEK EARLY CONSULTATION** - o ang agarang pagpapakonsulta sa doctor kapag may karamdaman. Iwasan din ang paginom ng gamot ng walang reseta mula sa doktor.
3. **SELF-PROTECTION MEASURES** - o ang pagprotektta sa sarili upang hindi makagat ng lamok sa pamamagitan ng pagsusunt ng mga damit na may mahahabang manggas, pagpapahid ng insect repellent sa mga bahagi ng halat na walang takip, at paggamit ng kusilbo sa pagtulog.
4. **SAY YES TO FOGGING IN TIMES OF IMPENDING OUTBREAK** - o ang pagpapabot, pero ilo ay gawin lamang sa mga panahong maaring bigkang lumito at dumaraan ang mga lamok.

Paano maiwasan ang dengue?

Hinihikayat ang lahat na magpatupad ng 4S kontra Dengue

1. **Search and destroy breeding places** – hanapin at sirain ang mga bagay na pwedeng maipunan ng malinis na tubig at pamahayan at pangitlukan ng lamok.
2. **Seek early consultation** – agad na komunsulta sa doktor kapag makaranas ng anumang sintomas ng dengue.
3. **Self-protection measures** – gumamit ng proteksyon laban sa kagat ng lamok tulad ng insect repellant, magsuot ng longsleeves, kulambo at iba pa.
4. **Say yes to fogging in times of impending outbreak** – maaring magpausok sa komunidad kung may banta ng dengue outbreak.



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
