In reference with DepEd Memorandum No. 030, s. 2018, this office through the curriculum and Instruction Division will conduct the 2018 ASEAN Division Quiz on March 19 \$2018 at Gabaldon Hall, Cabuyao Central School from 1:00 − 5:00 PM.

Participants to this activity are students from private and public schools from Grade 9 – 10, ages fifteen (15) – seventeen (17) years old and must not be eighteen (18) years old by the time of the Regional Competition which will be held in March 23. 2018 at Tanza National Comprehensive High, Tanza Cavite.

Relative to this, a meeting of planning and technical working committee is set on March 9, 2018 at the CID Conference Room at 1:00 PM.

Attached to this memorandum is enclosure 1-2.

Transportation and other related expenses of the participants in relation to their participation in this activity shall be charged to local funds subject to usual accounting rules and regulations.

Immediate and widest dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

I. Quiz Mechanics

- 1. The student-contestants from private and public Junior High School shall compete individually in two segments.
- The two segments are as follows: Segment 1. True or False and Multiple Choice Segment 2. Fill-in-the-Blanks or Completion
- Segment 1: True or False will be given 10 questions with 1 point for each correct answer and Multiple Choice will be 10 questions and be given 1 point also for each correct answer. Total score is 20 points
- 4. Segment 2: Fill-in-the Blanks or Completion is composed of 20 questions and every correct answer will be given 3 points. Total Score is 60 points.
- 5. The total accumulated point for the competition is 80 points.
- 6. Each participant shall be provided with a paper and pentel pen to answer the questions for segment 1 & 2.
- 7. For segment 1: (True or False and Multiple Choice) the contestants will write the word True or False for True or False items and the letter of the correct answer for the Multiple Choice items. Contestants will be given 10 seconds to write down their answer.
- 8. For Segment 2: (Fill-in-the-Blanks or completion), participants will be given 15 seconds to write down their answers. A buzzer shall indicate that the time is up. Answer shall be written in full; with no abbreviations or acronyms. Articles and prepositions should be written correctly. Answer with wrong spelling will be considered wrong. Corrections may be made by the participants but the previous answer must be crossed out within the given time allotment.
 - Each question in Segments 1 and 2 will be read twice. After the Quizmaster reads the questions the second time, he/she will say "GO". Only then will the participants write their answer. When the time is up, the Quizmaster will say "Markers/Pens Up." Participants will then up their Markers/Pens and Papers to show their answers. The Quizmaster will read aloud the answer of each participant. The scorers will record the answers accordingly. A cumulative score per participant will be announced by the Quizmaster after each round before moving on to the next segment.
- 9. After the completion of segment 2, the cumulative points of each participant in the two segments will be tabulated. The results will be examined by the DTWG. When the results have been verified, these will be submitted to the Board of Judges and announced accordingly by the Quizmaster.
- 10. The Chairman of the Board of Judges shall declare the First, Second and Third place winners. The first place winner will represent the region to the Regional ASEAN Quiz Competition. The Second/Third Place winners will be the alternate in case the First/Second winner unable to attend the competition.
- 11. In case of a tie, tiebreaker question/s shall be given until definite winner emerges. At the start of tiebreaker round, the scores revert to zero. A contestant who got the first three correct answers wins.
- 12. Should there be questions or protests, the Board of Judges shall decide the matter. Their decision is final.
- 13. Only the official contestants have the right to raise a protest with the assistance of the official coach.





II. Criteria for the Selection of the Participants

The student-participants for the Division ASEAN Quiz must:

- a. be in grades 9 to 10 between fifteen (15) and seventeen (17) years old; must not be eighteen (18) years old by the time of the REGIONAL Competition (International) which will be held in August 2018 at Indonesia;
- b. come from either a public or a private school;
- c. be proficient in English language both in oral and written;
- d. have a grade of 85 and above in Araling Panlipunan/Social Studies for the first quarter of School Year 2017-2018;
- e. have a good interpersonal skills/be a good team player;
- f. be physically fit;
- g. be willing (parental consent) to travel to Tanza, Cavite for the regional level and as well as for National Level in Quezon City and Regional (International)Competition in Indonesia, if he/she declared first place winner/one of the top three winners.
- h. meet other criteria that may be deemed necessary by the ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee.

III. Test Questions

- The test questions shall cover the three ASEAN Community Pillars-Political Security, economic and socio-cultural; ASEAN in General; and ASEAN Member States or AMS-specific.
- The division technical working group will prepare 5 questions for each category (True or False, Multiple Choice and Fill-in-the-Blanks or Completion) the questions will be forwarded to Dr. Magdalena S. Aragon, EPS 1- Araling Panlipunan on or before March 13, 2018.
- 3. Suggested materials include, among others, official ASEAN publications from the ASEAN Secretariat in Jakarta, Indonesia and the Department of Foreign Affairs Philippines, the ASEAN website (e.g. ASEAN Secretariat, ASEAN Communities, ASEANS Centers, etc.) website of the ASEAN Committee on Culture and Information, websites of all 10 ASEAN Member States and other relevant official websites.
