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- ✓ Class size – a maximum of 35 students
- ✓ Learning Resources - Availability of learning resources and materials on Korean language
- ✓ Teachers – Availability of at least two language teachers who will comply on the following conditions:
 - ✦ Will commit to attend and complete the language training course for 15 weeks from June to September 2018 (32 hours a week). Failure to finish the course will require the teacher to pay for the total cost of the training.
 - ✦ Will commit to travel to the training venue and from their work stations three times a week (Thursday, Friday, and Saturday)
 - ✦ Will commit to attend the intensive language course with cultural immersion in Korea upon completion, and to maintain an above satisfactory assessment from the language courses to be attended
 - ✦ Must be preferably 35 years old or younger upon application without any medical condition

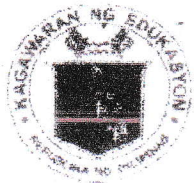

A NOTE TO THE PRINCIPAL/ SCHOOL HEAD:

Kindly ensure that the teachers who will be chosen for this Special Program in Foreign Language SPFL– Korean are up to mark on the following conditions:

- Will commit to attend and complete the language training course for 15 weeks from June – September 2018 (32 hours a week); Please underscore that if they decide to drop from the course, they will be required to pay for the total cost of the training fee. The venue of which will still be finalized. Due to the expansion, the SPFL team is currently looking for a possible alternative venue. At the moment the venue of the training is at the Korean Cultural Center at BGC Taguig.
- If the training will be at BGC Taguig, they will have to commit to travelling to and from their work station 3 times a week (Thursday, Friday, Saturday).
- Will commit to attend the intensive language course with cultural immersion in Korea upon completion and above satisfactory assessment from the language courses attended.
- They are preferably 35 years old and younger without any medical condition.

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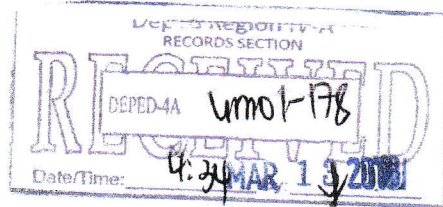

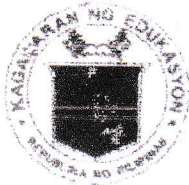
The Special Program in Foreign Language – Korean in partnership with the Korean Cultural Center is on its last phase of training the first batch of twenty teachers from ten schools in NCR.

By June 2018, these ten schools will open their doors to learners who will enlist under the SPFL – KOREAN program.

In line with this, the invitation to open SPFL – KOREAN is extended to five more schools in NCR and ten schools in CALABARZON.

The requirements for application from the DepEd Secondary schools are as follows:

1. Needs Assessment that is supported by the following documents:
 - a) **Survey Result** – SPFL KOREAN INTEREST SURVEY FORM (Template 1)
 - b) **Community mapping** that would justify the need to offer Korean Language. It would situate the school and Korean establishments around the vicinity that would enable the students to use their knowledge of the Korean language.
