AFS Intercultural Programs Philippines is an international volunteer-based, non-government, non-profit, organization that provides intercultural learning opportunities to help people develop the knowledge, skills and understanding needed to create a more just and peaceful world.

The importance of AFS Intercultural Programs has been greatly appreciated in the global community for 100 Years reaching more than 400,000 students and teachers, 440,000 volunteers and 50 countries, earning the organization a special citation from the United Nations for services to the youth of the world, and consultative partnership with UNESCO and ECOSOC.

In 2014, AFS commemorated the 100 years of its existence in promoting volunteerism and intercultural education towards a more just and peaceful world. In support to its mission, in 2017, AFS launched the Educators Assembly with the aim of institutionalizing AFS Intercultural learning programs in the country.
