## 2018 PLURAL + YOUTH VIDEO FESTIVAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS ALLIANCE OF CIVILIZATIONS AND INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR MIGRATION

The United Nations Alliance of Civilizations (UNAOC) and the International Organization for Migration (IOM) invite the youth to submit original and creative videos focusing on the PLURAL + theme of migration, diversity and social inclusion.

The festival aims to support dialogue between young people from different cultures, and in the process, increase their awareness and respect for diversity.

Video festival entries must abide by the following rules and regulations:

- 1. Entrants to PLURAL + must not be more than 25 years of age at the time of the production of the video submitted to PLURAL +. People appearing in the video need not be youth. Videos must reflect youth's view/opinions about migration, diversity and social inclusion;
- 2. Multiple youth may work together to make one video as long as all members of the group are not more than 25 years of age at the time of the production of the video submitted to PLURAL +;
- 3. All videos should be submitted as a file (preferably as "mov") via a file hosting website like dropbox.com, WeTransfer, Google drive, etc. The entrant may choose to mail a DVD of the video entry to the PLURAL + mailing address;
- 4. All videos that are not in English should have English subtitles;
- 5. All videos must be accompanied by a signed entry form;
- 6. PLURAL + will seek written consent of the parents or legal guardians of the makers of the winning video; and
- 7. Videos may be of whatever type, style or genre that the entrant wishes, e.g. animated, documentary, drama, music video, comedy etc.

The deadline for submission of entries is on June 3, 2018. The entry form and the instructions are downloadable at the PLURAL+ website at https://plural.unaoc.org.
