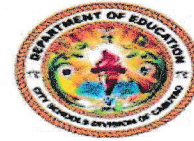

DATE: June 8, 2018

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 48 s. 2017 entitled 2017 Conduct of National Observances and Commemoration of Historical Events and related Activities, SDO will be hosting the **Commemoration of the 120th Independence Day Celebration on June 12, 2018 at Cabuyao Central School, City of Cabuyao, Laguna.**
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. commemorate the heroism, patriotism, nationalism, and self-sacrifice of the forefathers in the struggle of Independence.
 - b. instill in the hearts and minds of the youth the greatness of the Filipino race, the legacy of their national heroes, and ideals of their nationhood; and

3. There shall be a parade starting Cabuyao City Hall ground to Cabuyao Central School. Assembly will be at 6:00am.

5. All scouts and scouters, BSP & GSP must wear the **"TYPE A"** scouting uniform. Other participants are advised to wear Filipiniana attire.
