### INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON YOUTH, PEACE AND VIOLENT EXTREMISM OF THE WORLD YOUTH FOUNDATION

The World Youth Foundation invites participation to the International Conference on Youth, Peace and Violent Extremism from July 30 to August 3, 2018 in Melaka, Malaysia.

#### The conference aims to:

- 1. provide young people with the opportunity to share experiences and viewpoints on good practices in addressing the drivers of violent extremism;
- 2. identify the "push and pull factors" on the drivers of violent extremism;
- examine and discuss the role of youths in preventing the conditions that are conducive to violent extremism and promoting sustaining peaceful societies;
- 4. engage them worldwide in addressing the challenges related to prevention and countering of violent extremism (P/CVE);
- 5. include them in the decision making process on P/CVE issues as highlighted in United Nations Security Council Resolution (USCR) 2250;
- 6. discuss ways to strengthen the links between P/CVE and the related Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) as fully implementing the SDGs, with a focus on SDG 16 will help prevent violent extremism by addressing the socio, economic, political factors that enable radicalization; and
- 7. empower youths through capacity building and offering opportunities for networking and cooperation.

Youth organizations, nongovernment organizations, civil society organizations, United Nations agencies, the academe, corporate agencies, and related stakeholders are encouraged to send students or representatives/officials aged 18–32 years old. Limited slots will be available for those aged above 32 years old.
